

Biography: Michael Goodstein, FAAP

Michael Goodstein is a board-certified neonatologist from York, PA. He did both a residency in pediatrics and a fellowship in Neonatal-Perinatal Medicine at Temple University/St. Christopher's Hospital for Children. Dr. Goodstein has been an attending neonatologist for 24 years at York Hospital for the WellSpan Medical Group and he is a Clinical Associate Professor of Pediatrics at the College of Medicine of The Pennsylvania State University. He established the York County Cribs for Kids Program and has been its director since 2003. He is a board member of the National Cribs for Kids® Program and was conference chairman for their fourth (2015) and fifth (2017) national infant safe sleep conferences. He has been a member of the Expert Leadership Group for the National Action Partnership to Promote Safe Sleep (2014-2017) and a safe sleep content advisor for the Infant Mortality Collaborative Improvement and Innovation Network (ColIN) (2015-2017). He was recently asked to be Faculty Co-Chair of the Expert Advisory Committee for the NAPPSS-IIN (NICHQ, HRSA). Dr. Goodstein has been a member of the AAP Task Force on SIDS since 2010.
