Jenny Kurinczuk is Director of the National Perinatal Epidemiology Unit (NPEU) and Co-director of the DH-funded Policy Research Unit in Maternal Health and Care which is based in the NPEU. Jenny's research focuses on the causes and consequences of conditions from conception through pregnancy which affect pregnancy outcomes and the health of the babies as they grow and develop during infancy, childhood and beyond. These include newborn brain dysfunction (neonatal encephalopathy), cerebral palsy, congenital anomalies, and the health and development of children born following assisted reproductive technologies. She is national programme lead for the MBRRACE-UK collaboration responsible for the national surveillance of maternal and perinatal deaths and confidential enquiries into maternal and infant deaths and severe morbidity and the national Perinatal Mortality Review Tool (PMRT). She is also a collaborator on studies of near miss maternal morbidity through the UK Obstetric Surveillance System (UKOSS).
